

Unionville school directors accept FieldTurf proposal

Board accepts check for \$100,000 from Unionville Sports Council

The Unionville-Chadds Ford School Board voted Monday 7-2 to approve the proposal from FieldTurf for the artificial turf project, totaling \$1,091,646, with board members Therese West and Timotha Trigg voting against the proposal.

The cost also includes the

price of the Stevens property, which was just over \$872,000

Trigg said that although she supports the idea of a turf field, she rejected how this particular project came about.

This whole project is based on under the cap spending, which concerns me greatly," she said.

Coming in the middle of an emotional meeting, the turf field project was met with much public support as several residents gave their opinions on why the community should support the

project.

The board also accepted a \$100,000 check from the Unionville Sports Council for the field project, an announcement that brought the 100-plus crowd to its feet, with all eyes turned to USC founder Joe Carney.

According to Board Member Paul Price, with the project approved on Monday evening the fields should be ready by Aug. 13, in time for the fall sports season to begin.
